THE ARMED FORCES (EMERGENCY DUTIES) ACT, 1947.

An Act to enable duties in connection with vital services to be imposed in an emergency on the Armed Forces of ²[Pakistan].

WHEREAS it is expedient to enable duties in connection with vital services to be imposed in an emergency on the Armed Forces of ²[Pakistan]; It is hereby enacted as follows:—

- **1. Short title and extent.** (1) This Act may be called the Armed Forces (Emergency Duties) Act, 1947.
 - ³[(2) It extends to the whole of Pakistan.]
- **2. Emergency duties of Armed Forces.** (1) The ⁴[Federal Government] may, by notification⁵ in the official Gazette, declare any specified service to be a service of vital importance to the community:

Provided that such notification shall remain in force for one month in the first instance, but may be extended, from time to time, by a like notification.

- (2) Upon a declaration being made under sub-section (1) and until it is rescinded, it shall be the duty of every person subject to ⁶* * * the Pakistan Army Act, 1952], ⁶* * * ⁷[or the Pakistan Air Force Act, 1953], or the ⁸[Pakistan Navy Ordinance, 1961], to obey any command given by any superior officer in relation to employment upon or in connection with the service specified in the declaration; and every such command shall be deemed to be a lawful command within the meaning and for the purposes of the said Acts ⁹[or Ordinance].
