**No.F.9(39)/2021-Legis.**—The following Act of *Majlis-e-Shoora* (Parliament) received the assent of the President on 20th July, 2021 and is hereby published for general information:—

ACT No. X OF 2021

*An Act to amend the Enforcement of Women's Property Rights Act, 2020  
(XII of 2020)*

WHEREAS, it is expedient to amend the Enforcement of Women's Property Rights Act, 2020 (XII of 2020) for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows:—

1. **Short title and commencement.**— (1) This Act shall be called the Enforcement of Women's Property Rights (Amendment) Act, 2021.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. **Amendment of section 5, Act XII of 2020.** — In the Enforcement of Women’s Property Rights Act, 2020 (XII of 2020), in section 5, after sub-section 3, the following sub-section (4) shall be inserted, namely:—

“(4) Any person aggrieved by a decision of Ombudsman under sub-section (1), may, within thirty days of decision, make a representation to the President, who may pass such order thereon as he may deem fit.”
